- Be historically underserved students who self-identify as Black or African American; Hispanic or Latino; or American Indian or Alaska Native
- Be United States citizens or permanent residents

Selection Criteria:

An Altum selection committee will handle the evaluation and selection process. Preference will be given to students who:

- Demonstrate a strong academic record
- Show leadership potential
- Demonstrate a dedication to community service
- Present evidence of financial need

- A completed FAFSA Form
- An essay (300 word max)
